With a twinkle in his eyes and a smile on his face, Justice Alan Page entertained kids of all ages by reading his "Bee Love" book at the Richfield Farmers Market on August 12. He patiently endured airplanes flying over his head and other distractions as he was reading. He then fielded questions, posed for photos and personally greeted many "fans" in attendance.

Justice Page also shared the "Elevator of Success" philosophy he lives by and encouraged others to follow it as well. He described people spending their entire lives riding the elevator of success to the top. But it is what they do when they get there that makes all the difference in the world. Some people get off the elevator and spend the rest of their lives enjoying the fruits of their labor! But many years ago, someone instilled in Justice Page the idea that once you reach the top - please send the elevator back down and help others get started on their ride to the top. So even though he just celebrated his 78th birthday, Justice Page keeps sending the elevator back down to help others, which is evident by the 9,000 minority students who have benefited from the Page Scholars program since its inception in 1988.

At the end of our time with Justice Page that day, a young man and his wife approached him. The young man wanted to thank

Justice Page because he indeed was a Page Scholar in 2010. Justice Page just lit up. He asked the young man how he was doing, asked to take a selfie with him and jotted some notes in his phone for his team at the Page Education Foundation. It looked like Justice Page was more excited to see the young man than the young man was to see him!



The credit union industry has the "People Helping People" philosophy, which resembles the "Elevator of Success" mantra of Justice Page. What an inspiration, role model and Hall of Fame person (who is also in the NFL Hall of Fame, by the way)! Thank you, Justice Page!

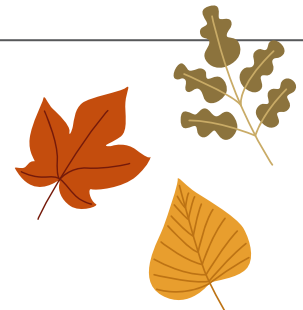

You Can't Always Put a Face to Fraud

But you can put a stop to it.



Identity theft is one of the fastest growing crimes in the country. And here at MY CREDIT UNION, we are doing all we can to help protect you. One growing fraud tactic we want you to be aware of is voice phishing, or vishing calls.

In vishing scams, callers pretend to be your bank, credit card company or other company to get you to give them personal and financial information. A vishing caller may make claims about the status of your credit card or other accounts. They then ask for your bank or credit card information, which they use to steal your identity and money.

Put a stop to vishing scams! Follow these tips to protect yourself from fraud:

- When a caller claims to represent MY CREDIT UNION, your credit card company or another company, hang up and call the company's official number. Always verify the company's number with the information you have, like the back of your credit card or a trusted website.
- Avoid providing personal or financial information over the phone, especially if you did not initiate the call.
- MY CREDIT UNION will NEVER call you and ask for your credit card or account information.
- Notify the company being impersonated if you receive a scam call. You can also report the call to the Federal Communications Commission at www.fcc.gov/complaints or 888.225.5322.
