

Day 1: Monday, November 3, 2025 Overnight Flight Get ready for a true taste of southern Spain, from the sparkling blue waters of Costa del Sol to the chic avenues of Madrid. Your tour begins with an overnight flight.

Day 2: Tuesday, November 4, 2025 Málaga, Spain - Fuengirola Welcome to Málaga, one of the oldest cities in Europe, known for its sunny, Andalusian lifestyle and for being the birthplace of artist Pablo Picasso. Settle into your new surroundings and start enjoying the town of Fuengirola. Depending on your flight arrival time, join your Tour Manager and fellow travelers this evening for a welcome reception at your hotel.

Day 3: Wednesday, November 5, 2025 Fuengirola - Málaga - Fuengirola Discover the port city of Málaga with a local guide. Walk through the colorful market stalls and learn about the history and culture of this seaside community. Let Málaga's winding old town streets and historic Roman Theatre transport you back in time. Top off your day in Málaga being welcomed into a local's home for lunch. After lunch, you will enjoy the afternoon at leisure. Early this evening, attend a Flamenco show before returning to Fuengirola. In Fuengirola this evening, gather for dinner at a local restaurant to celebrate the journey's beginning. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Thursday, November 6, 2025 Fuengirola - Ronda - Fuengirola Travel to Ronda! Like many of the Andalusian white villages, has deep ties to the Arab population that once ruled the region. Walk the Old Town and see its 18th-century Puente Nuevo (New Bridge) over the El Tajo gorge. After some free time to explore on your own, head back to Fuengirola where the sunsets beckon a relaxing ending to the day. (B)

Day 5: Friday, November 7, 2025 Fuengirola - Marbella - Fuengirola Journey to romantic Marbella today and enjoy a walking tour of the city's winding cobblestone streets before spending some free time exploring Marbella's charming shops, cafés, and galleries on your own. Afterward, you'll join a tour to Mijas, one of Andalusia's most famous villages. Mijas Pueblo is a storybook Andalusian village. Discover old-world charm, whitewashed buildings perched high on the mountainside, spectacular views to the Mediterranean coastline, and a scenic backdrop of endless pine forests. Take time to explore the town as you choose, perhaps searching the shops for locally-produced art, like handmade linen and wicker items. End your visit to Mijas with an included dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 6: Saturday, November 8, 2025 Fuengirola - Granada - Fuengirola Today travel to Granada, the last capital of the Moors in Spain before it fell to the Catholic monarchs in 1492. Here, spend the morning with a local expert visiting the Alhambra,\* a UNESCO World Heritage site also known as one of the Wonders of the Muslim world. After your extensive morning walk at this centuries-old palace and fortress complex, enjoy some free time in Granada for lunch on your own before

Then join a panoramic tour of Madrid's historic center to see iconic sites like the Gran Via and Puerta de Alcala, and get the lay of this capital city. Tonight, experience a dinner with traditional entertainment at a local restaurant and discover the gorgeous Plaza Mayor. (B, D)

Day 8: Monday, November 10, 2025 Madrid – Segovia – Madrid Retrace history in Segovia, a city with 2,000 years of stories within its walls. Walk the medieval streets, making your way to The Alcazar of Segovia (UNESCO). This dreamy palace is shaped like the bow of a ship and had humble beginnings as a Roman fort. Legend has it that Sergovia was founded by Hercules, giving the city a legendary background story only matched by the grandeur of its Roman Aqueduct. Whatever draws you to Segovia, its streets and charm set in the rolling hills of Castilla will be sure to impress you! Tonight, bid farewell to Spain and your fellow travelers during dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 9: Tuesday, November 11, 2025 Madrid - Tour Ends Your tour comes to a close today. Reflect on the warmth and spirit of the Costa del Sol as you journey home. (B)

Located in the Spanish region of Andalusia, Costa del Sol, or Sun Coast, has appealed to citizens of Europe—and the rest of the world—for centuries. The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an onthe-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

The walking tour of the Alhambra will take approximately 3 hours.

### Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

From mid-June to mid-September, temperatures can easily reach 90 degrees.

Dinner times follow local custom and will be served at 7:30 p.m. or later.

Due to local festivities, the order of your included visits may change.

\*Alhambra tickets are not guaranteed and subject to availability per Spanish Governing Authority. On the rare occasion that tickets are not available for your entire group, you will visit another top Spanish attraction and your group leader or travel agent will be notified. Complete passport information is required 150 days prior to departure to book tickets to the Alhambra. If passport information is incomplete or inaccurate within 150 days prior to your tour departure, there is a strong possibility that we will be unable to confirm entrance tickets. You will be subject to any additional charges incurred from failing to provide passport information within the designated time frame.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Due to traffic regulations, buses cannot reach historic city centers. This means at times, the bus may drop the group off at one location but pick it up elsewhere. If you opt out of an activity, you'll need to arrange your own transfer to the next bus pick-up spot, as passengers cannot remain on the bus during stops due to European regulations.

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your <u>own air</u>, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our air passengers will arrive into Malaga, Spain and transfer to Fuengirola.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

### IDENTIFICATION

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.



IMPORTANT: We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Effective for travel in May 2025, all visitors who do not need a visa to enter Europe will be expected to apply for an ETIAS visa waiver, for a fee, when visiting a Schengen Area Country. \*\*A small overnight bag is required. Your main luggage will be transferred from Málaga to Madrid on the night prior of the train ride. We recommend bringing a cabin-sized duffle bag or backpack, large enough to pack your overnight belongings. You will be responsible for handling this overnight bag and any other luggage you wish to bring with you on the train.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.
